

# Individual Campout Checklist

A **Class A** Cub Scout uniform is required for Pack Camp-outs. Scouts will arrive in and depart from campouts in **Class A** uniform. During activities a scout may wear **Class B** or appropriate comfortable clothing. Sturdy shoes that are suitable for hiking will be useful. The following is a list of equipment that would be useful on the campout. Check off each item in pencil as you lay out your equipment pack.

Bring your own shelter, mess kit and cooking equipment will be furnished by the Pack.

- □ Tent or tarp, poles, and stakes
- □ Waterproof ground cloth or plastic sheet
- □ Sleeping bag, pillow, air mattress or pad

- □ Warm jacket or coat
- □ Pajamas or sweatshirt, sweatpants
- □ Underwear
- □ Durable shoes, shoe laces

- □ Folding Camp chairs
- □ Cooler or ice chest
- □ Cot or pad
- □ Toilet Kit
- □ Toothpaste, toothbrush, comb
- □ Washcloth, towel
- □ Soap in container
- □ Extra plastic bag or container

#### First Aid

- □ Small First aid kit
- □ Water bottle
- □ Flashlight, bulb, batteries
- □ Sunscreen
- □ Insect repellent
- □ Safety pins

- Binoculars
- Sunglasses
- □ Notebook and pencil
- □ Nature books

- □ Toys
- □ Knives
- □ Small electronics (iPods, CD players)
